# MEET A BOARD MEMBER Freddie D. Montgomery Jr.

Freddie D. Montgomery Jr. was sworn in as Fire Chief of Clarksville Fire Rescue by Mayor Joe Pitts on August 1, 2019. He and his wife, Priscilla have been married for 30 years. They have two sons, Calvin and Cameron, and 3 grandchildren. Chief Montgomery, a Hopkinsville Kentucky native, Graduated from Christian County High School in 1990 and went on to serve as an infantryman in the U.S. Army's 9th Infantry Regiment from 1990-93. He joined the Hopkinsville Fire Department in 1994 as a firefighter EMT where he served for 25 years capping off his time at HFD as Fire Chief and EMS Director for the last 5 years of his career. He retired from HFD with a host of accolades including improving the city ISO rating to help lower citizens insurance premiums, a Key to the City, 2015 Employee of the year for the entire state of Kentucky, and a Citation of Achievement from the Kentucky House of Representatives for his work restructuring EMS services to save nearly a halfmillion dollars in Christian County (Kentucky's second-largest county). He also served on several boards: Christian County American Red Cross, Hopkinsville Christian County YMCA, Tennessee River American Red Cross, 2nd VP of the Kentucky Fire Chiefs Association to name a few. He is a graduate of the International Association of Fire Chiefs' Executive Chief Officer 2 program, Leadership Hopkinsville, & Leadership Clarksville. In the 4 years at Clarksville Fire Rescue, he has restructured the CFR Emergency response, implemented an independent district response concept to ensure adequate resources to all calls. He has worked to improve emergency response, facilities, staffing, equipment, protective gear, training, pay, diversity, and professional appearance. Chief Montgomery has successfully received over 5 million dollars in federal grants to help change CFR's trajectory, but his proudest accomplishment would be leading the charge to connect CFR to the community as engaged partners and resources at times and events other than emergencies.
